Summary Itinerary

Sunday, July 15

Tuesday, July 17

Flight from Bali to *Mataram, Lombok (AM)*. Meet members of local partner YKSSI to learn about their overall objectives.

Wednesday, July 18

First community visit (Lantan Village) to meet with community members and see their work in potable water management, livestock-biogas-organic fertilizer, saving and credit group, post harvest, collective marketing, cooperative for poor family, hydrology management for electric.

Thursday, July 19

Field trip to the second village (Karang Sidemen Village) and learn about their work in social forestry, disaster management and community organizing, nutrition and health, spring water conservation, garden management for vegetables, and debrief with team about village visits

Friday, July 20

In Lombok. Opportunities for tourism in Lombok.

Saturday, July 21

Return to Bali (AM). Opportunities for tourism in Bali. Evening group meal

Sunday, July 22

Tourism in Bali - cultural presentation such as dancing, shadow puppet show, etc.

Monday, July 23

Return to USA or Bali. Opportunities for tourism there or return home.
